My sister and I did not want to go to class, so we stopped going.

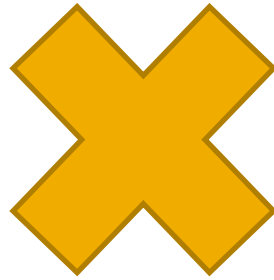
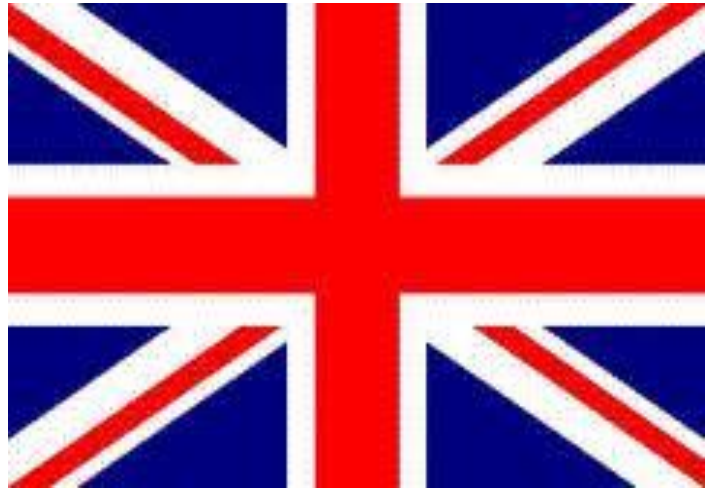
I do not remember the books we used because my daddy threw in the trash when we did a cleaning in 'house of mess'.
