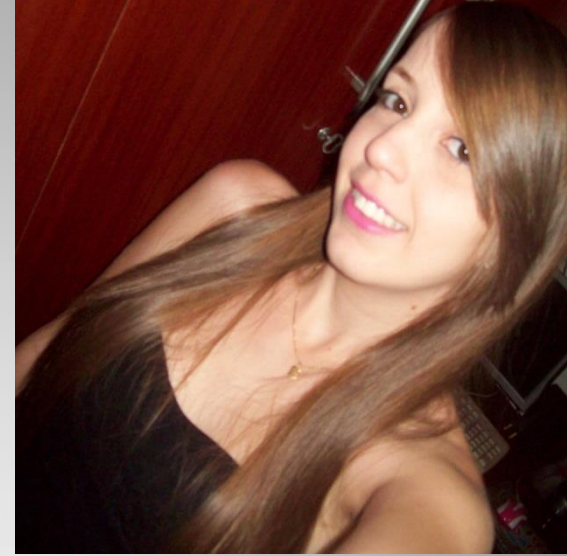
Good evening!

* My hobby is listening to music in my spare time.

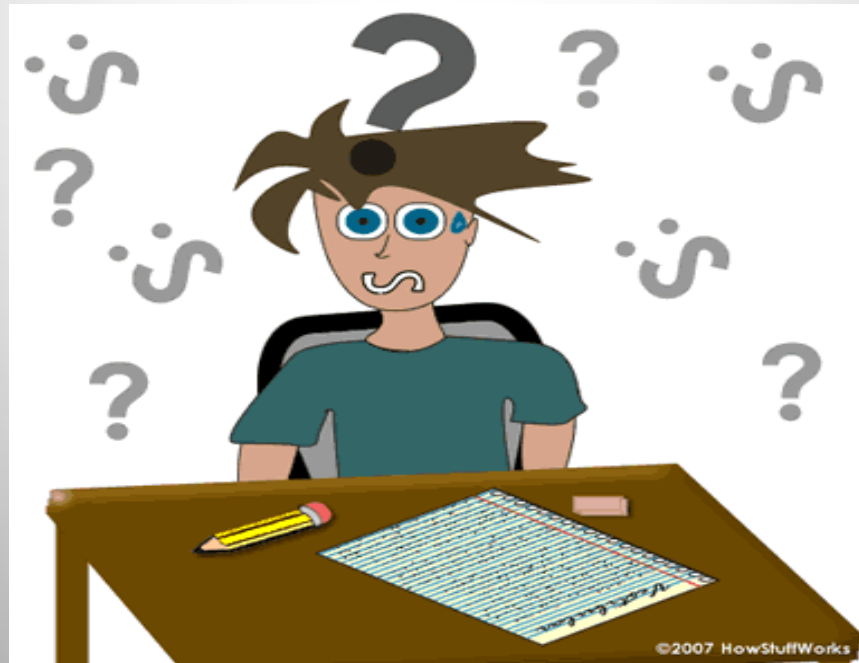
* I like places where I have contact with nature. I love animals!

My experience

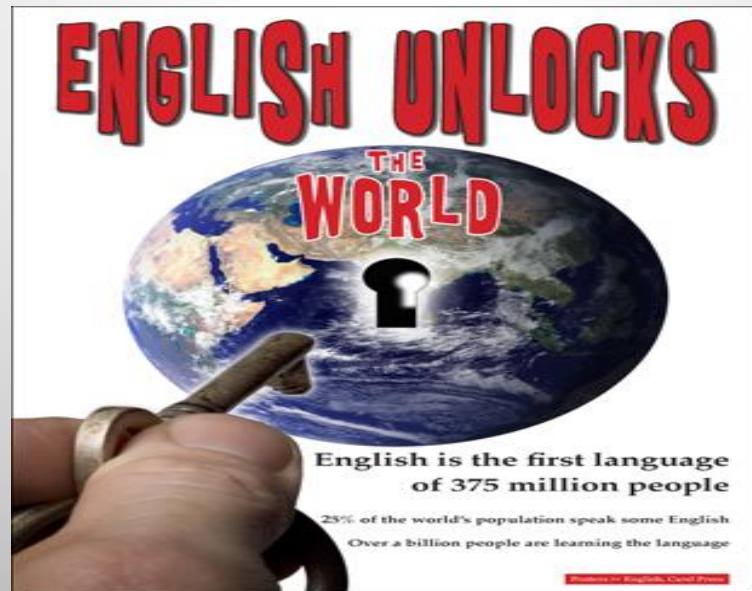
