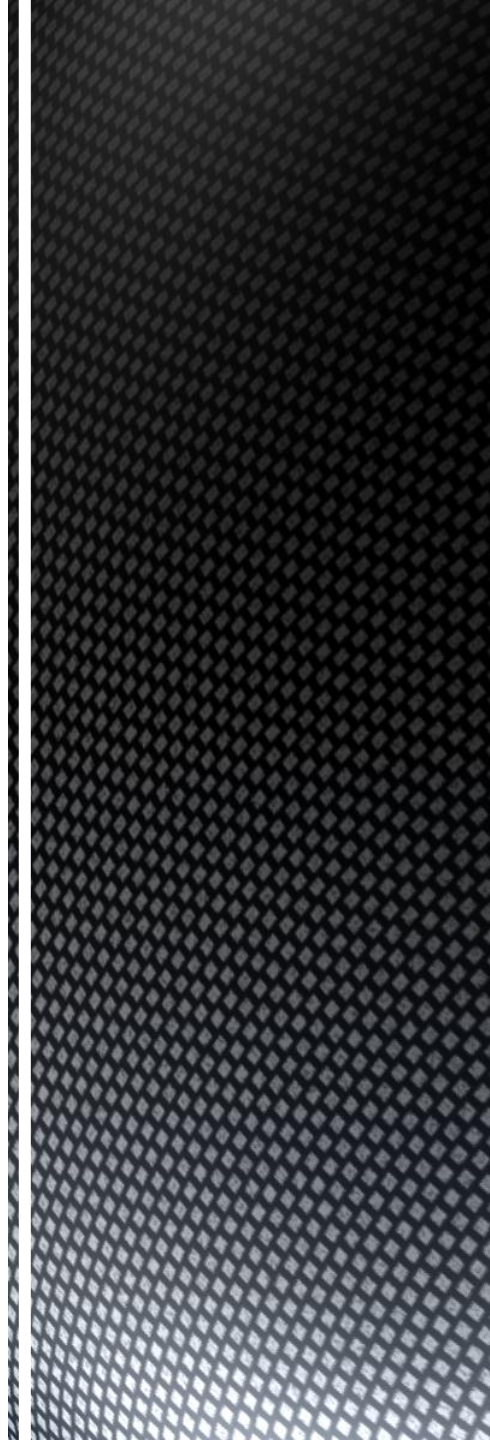
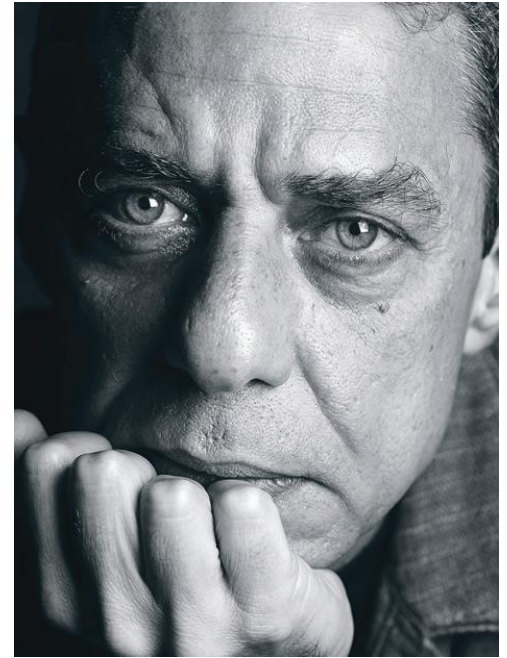


Final Narrative

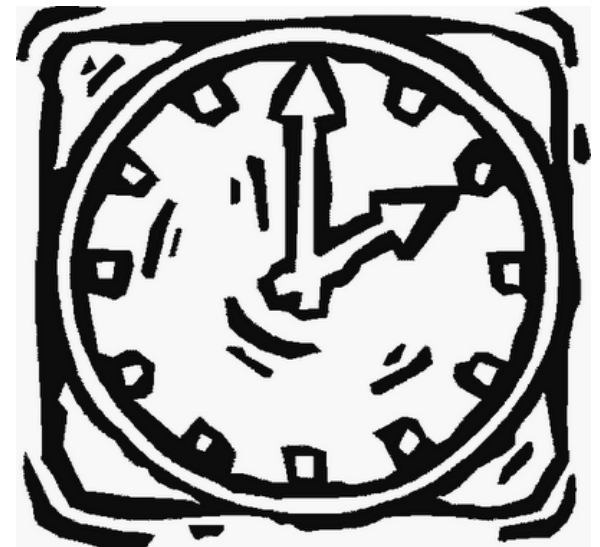
Bruna Cabral

- I love music, I love Bossa Nova and the Brazilian singers, like Chico Buarque, Marisa Monte, Maria Rita, Elis Regina, and others.



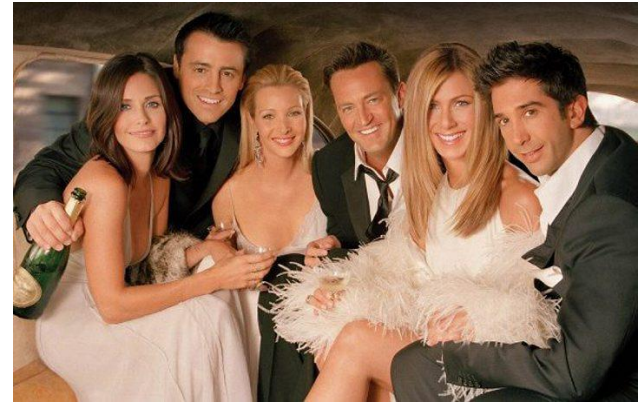
- I started to learn English early, with 10 years old, at school.
